

## Oakley Cricket Club Selection Policy

Version 2.0 11/04/2018

- 1. The selection committee will consist of the three team captains plus a Director of Cricket.
- 2. The selection committee will meet to agree selection on the Wednesday before weekend matches take place.
- 3. Selection priority will be given to players who:
  - I. have paid their annual membership.
  - II. make it known that they are available for a match BEFORE the selection meeting (i.e. before 6pm on the Wednesday before the weekend matches)
  - III. if there are more players available than places, priority will be given to those who have supported club activities, after the captains have made their initial selections
  - IV. paid up members who are not selected on a Saturday will have priority for selection on the Sunday XI
- 4. The Sunday XI, is also the development XI for younger players, and as such the selection committee may want to request the Sunday Captain to give certain players a bowl or "bat up the order" if appropriate. This may also apply to giving established league players prominent roles in a game should it be felt they need extra match practice to recover form.
- 5. All 3 scorebooks should be available at selection meetings, so if required it can be seen who has done what and team captains can provide details of pertinent circumstances, i.e. is a player in a run of poor form or suffering a run of bad luck etc.
- 6. Batting and bowling Orders will be at the captain's discretion.
- 7. Should a player have a wish to discuss any issue regarding selection etc. or has a grievance, they should talk to either the relevant team captain or the appointed Director of Cricket (currently Paul Sumner).
